Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Scotland and parts of Northern Ireland will remain cloudy with rain at times, heavy for northeast Scotland. Elsewhere, turning brighter after a grey start, but with showers in places, these heavy and thundery in the south later. Tonight, rain continuing for Scotland. Elsewhere, clear spells, but further showers for England.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:  
Thursday will be rather cloudy with rain in places, this especially in the northeast. However, this will clear southwards Thursday night to leave Friday as a dry day with plenty of sunshine, though it will be colder. A sharp frost is likely Friday night.
