

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Icy patches to start in south Wales and much of England. Rather foggy for many, persisting locally, with the northeast brightest throughout. Meanwhile, southern and western UK may see drizzle, with isolated snow flurries towards the southeast. Overnight, frost and further fog patches will develop, the frost locally severe in clear spells over snowfields. Cloudier and milder in the west.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Mainly dry and cold on both days, with sunshine limited by areas of fog, particularly in southern and southeastern UK. Generally brighter towards the north, however some rain and hill snow is possible at times in the milder far northwest.
