

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Outbreaks of rain perhaps lingering across some far southeastern parts of England this morning. Some showers affecting southern and western coastal areas, becoming heavy in places later. Elsewhere, dry with sunny spells. Showers, locally heavy, mainly along southern and western coastal parts, continuing overnight. Drier elsewhere with clear spells leading to patchy fog and local frost, especially in the north.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:  
Fog patches slowly clearing on Monday and showers near some coasts, locally heavy in the southeast. Later, rain and stronger winds moving into Northern Ireland, Wales and southwest England. Wet and windy for many on Tuesday, with coastal gales possible.

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
