

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A rather cloudy day across much of the UK, but a sunny start across the Kent. Outbreaks of locally heavy rain over Wales, central and southern England will spread north and east during the day. The rain clearing southwestern parts by afternoon, leaving some brightness and a scattering of showers. Windy in west.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
More rain is expected over Northern Ireland , southern Scotland and northwest England on Wednesday, but elsewhere it will be largely dry with some brightness and perhaps some sunshine in places. Much of the UK will be wet on Thursday, but becoming drier and brighter in the west.
