Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain across many northern areas, heavy at times, will progress slowly southeastwards through the day, reaching central areas by evening. Brighter, showery weather will follow the rain across northwestern areas. Some bright spells will precede the rain with isolated showers. The rainband will reach southeastern areas overnight with drier but showery conditions following, especially across western Scotland. Foggy in places.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

The rain will slowly clear the southeast on Saturday with sunshine and showers following, heaviest and most frequent in the west. Feeling rather cold across all areas. Largely dry and bright on Sunday with only isolated showers in the northwest.
