Headline:

Cloud and rain spreading southeastwards followed by sunnier skies Tuesday.

This Evening and Tonight:

Patchy fog and frost for the southeast. Rain spreading southeastwards across northern and western areas. Scotland and Northern Ireland, mostly dry and clear later.

Tuesday:

Rain across northern and western England and Wales spreading southeastwards, but not clearing the far southeast of England until after dark. Sunnier skies followed from the northwest.

Outlook for Wednesday:

Mostly dry with some sunshine after a frosty start.
