

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A rather cloudy day is expected with scattered showers, becoming locally heavy this afternoon, and just occasional bright spells. Some more persistent rain is likely over north Wales and northwest England this morning too. Rather windy in the south. Becoming largely dry with clear spells tonight, although cloud and rain will affect southern England, south Wales and northern Scotland.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
Cloud and rain will spread northeastwards across most parts during Wednesday, with sunny spells and showers widely at first, persisting through the day over much of Scotland. Staying unsettled on Thursday with rain gradually giving way to showers from the west.
