

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Mainly dry and breezy to start with some brightness. Heavy rain and gales across Scotland will push southeastwards, reaching southeastern England by dusk. Colder weather will follow with wintry showers in places. The rain will clear all but the extreme southeast overnight with further scattered wintry showers in the northwest. It will be cold with patchy frost and ice.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
Remaining unsettled with sunshine and scattered showers that may be wintry, particularly across northern hills. Winds will be strong and showers may merge into longer spells of rain, sleet or snow. It will stay cold with overnight frost and ice.
