Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Early fog patches in the east should quickly clear. After a dull morning in southeastern England with a few showers, it will become largely dry by the afternoon with sunny spells. Showers across the north and west of the UK at the beginning of the day, will spread to most other areas by the afternoon, turning heavy at times.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

It will remain showery across many parts through Thursday and Friday, with showers likely to turn heavy and more persistent at times, giving a risk of thunder. Drier and brighter spells are also expected, mainly across central England on Thursday.
