Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Wintry showers over Scotland and Northern Ireland becoming less frequent by evening. After a bright or sunny start, showers soon developing over England and Wales. Some showers heavy with hail and thunder, falling as snow on hills, also wintry on low ground. Windy, particularly in the east. Feeling cold. Showers dying out overnight, winds falling light and widespread frost.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Monday, sunny start, cloud increasing over Scotland and Northern Ireland. Rain and strong winds in northwest later. Feeling pleasantly warm in sunshine elsewhere. Tuesday, rain clearing all but south of England and Wales, becoming brighter with showers further north. Quite windy.
