Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Across southern England and Wales it'll be cold with some dense fog around, which may be slow to clear. Elsewhere, there'll be some bright spells which will gradually become more widespread, except for across the far north of Scotland where it will remain damp. In any brightness across north-east Scotland, it will turn very mild.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Into next week the weather remains similar on Monday with dull, damp and foggy conditions continuing in the south. There will be some brightness, especially across North Wales, northern England eastern Scotland, however rain and stronger winds will arrive in the north-west on Tuesday.
