Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
After a rather cold start, with some mist or fog patches lifting during the morning, it will then be a fine day for most with plenty of warm sunshine, especially across England, Wales and southern Scotland. It will be a little cloudier at times further north, with the odd light shower possible. Another chilly night then follows.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

It will remain dry throughout with some warm sunny spells, and variable amount of cloud. However, it is likely to become chilly overnight under clear skies. Winds will generally remain light, but it will become a little breezy in the south later.
