Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Many places will start dry with some sunshine, though northwestern areas will have a few showers. More general cloud and outbreaks of rain will spread southeastwards to Scotland, Northern Ireland and northern England this morning, then to parts of Wales and central England this afternoon. It will be warmer for southeast England, but it will become increasingly windy, especially in the north with gales likely in the far north by evening.

Tonight, it will remain mostly cloudy, but mild with a little rain in places, though with heavier showers for western Scotland. It will be very windy with gales for Scotland and northeast England.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Scotland, Northern Ireland and northern England will have sunshine and showers. The rest of England and Wales will be generally cloudy, but mostly dry. Gales in the north will ease.
