

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Monday 28 Apr 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:

A grey start for many, but sunny spells developing away from southern Scotland and northeast England where there could be some patchy rain. Heavy, thundery downpours developing in some southern areas of England and Wales. Very warm in sheltered northwest Scotland. Gradually becoming largely dry overnight, but turning murky again in parts of the east and northeast.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Some bright or sunny spells for many, but also scattered showers developing on both days, most widespread in the south, heavy at times. Cloudier in the north with outbreaks of patchy rain, and this will slowly edge southwards throughout the period.
