

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Tuesday 17 Jul 2012

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain, heavy at times across Northern Ireland, southern Scotland and northern England, with grey and drizzly conditions around many other western coasts and hills. Elsewhere, a good deal of dry weather, and feeling warm and humid in any brightness. Further heavy and persistent rain will spread to many western and northern areas overnight, accompanied by strengthening winds.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

A wet day across much of Scotland, away from the far north. Heavy, thundery showers will break out across many parts of England and Wales, with brighter, fresher conditions following on. Still a risk of heavy showers on Thursday, mainly in the south.
