

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Eastern parts of England and Scotland will have a dry and warm day with sunny intervals. Western areas will on the whole be cloudier with patchy drizzly rain and extensive low cloud shrouding hills. Tonight eastern areas will remain dry. Further west it will be generally cloudy with rain or drizzle at times. Northwestern Scotland will become wet and windy.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Tomorrow patchy rain moving southeastwards will become increasingly light and will have reached southern Wales and central England by evening. Sunshine and scattered showers will follow into northern areas. On Wednesday there will be a mixture of sunshine and showers.
