Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Many central and eastern areas will start dry, but frosty, but it should be sunny for a time. However, showers, already affecting northern and some western areas will develop more widely with time, some of these heavy, perhaps with hail. It should feel less cold than recently.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

It will remain unsettled throughout with some sunny spells, but also showers. Some of these will be heavy with a risk of hail and thunder, and may merge into some longer spells of rain in places. It will remain rather cool for the time of year with a continuing risk of overnight frost.
