Headline:

Bright in the north. Outbreaks of rain spreading northwestwards.

Today:

Patchy fog in the north clearing, then bright here for a time. Otherwise dull with outbreaks of rain spreading north, turning more showery in the south.

Tonight:

Showery rain spreading north across Scotland, then most places becoming dry, but misty.

Outlook for Wednesday:

Patchy rain across Scotland clearing. Most places starting dry, but cloudy. Rain spreading to western and some central areas, locally heavy.
