

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Saturday 02 Nov 2013

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Some fog this morning, especially northern England. Rain, heavy at times, will spread across the UK from the west, followed by blustery showers. Winds will strengthen, especially in the south, where severe gales are likely around coasts. Heavy rain across northern Scotland, with snow on the Grampians, persisting overnight, with blustery showers and strong winds continuing elsewhere.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Strong winds and blustery showers at first on Sunday will gradually ease through the day. Further rain will spread across southwest England later, becoming heavy at times overnight. Early rain clearing the south on Monday, then largely dry and fine with some sunshine.
