

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Outbreaks of rain, heavy at first, moving southeastwards across Scotland and Northern Ireland. Elsewhere, rather dull, cloudy and cold with patchy drizzle, but some sunny spells across western Wales and southwest England. Rain continuing southeastwards overnight, and turning to snow over some Scottish hills. Clear spells and showers following, with frost and icy patches forming later. Cloudy and damp elsewhere.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Southeastern parts cloudy, breezy and cold with some rain on Tuesday. Elsewhere, largely dry and sunny after a frosty start. The odd wintry shower in the far north. Then mostly dry on Wednesday, with local overnight frost and fog patches.
