Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Fresher and breezier, with broken cloud and scattered showers. The showers heavier and most prevalent towards the northwest of the United Kingdom. Sunniest to the south and east of the Midlands, where showers are unlikely. Predominantly cloudy and breezy tonight with rain steadily spreading from the west, though clearer across northeast Britain.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Largely cloudy and windy on Tuesday with spells of rain, though brighter with scattered showers across northern and eastern Scotland. The rain heavy at times across Northern Ireland, northwest England and North Wales. Rather cold and blustery on Wednesday, with a mix of sunshine and scattered heavy showers.
