Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Sunny spells and scattered slow-moving thundery showers will affect the southern half of the UK. Rather cloudy and cool across central parts with outbreaks of rain, but mainly dry and sunny across northern areas. Outbreaks of rain will continue across central Britain overnight, and showers in the south will largely die out leaving patchy mist or fog.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Further slow-moving thundery showers will develop across southern parts of the UK on Saturday but they will be less widespread than today. It will be drier on Sunday, although showers are still likely. The north and west will stay mostly dry and fine.
