#### General Situation

A large area of high pressure is centred across the United Kingdom, with light winds across most areas, but stronger winds are likely at times through the English Channel.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

Moderate or rough, but smooth or slight in Moray Firth.

Rough or very rough, but smooth or slight to east of Shetland.
