Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
A band of rain will move into much of England and Wales on Monday, with heavy and persistent outbreaks across parts of Wales and northwest England especially. It will also be unseasonably windy across many areas, with the risk of coastal gales along southern and western coasts of England and Wales in particular.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

The rain will continue to affect eastern and northeastern parts of England and Scotland on Tuesday, with limited sunny spells and scattered squally showers arriving from the west. Wednesday will be mostly dry and bright, but further rain is then likely to arrive from the west later.
