

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Thursday 06 Mar 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain across northwestern parts becoming heavier later. Brighter and colder for a time in northern Scotland with scattered showers. Patchy rain or drizzle across western England and Wales. Best of the brightness in southeast and to lee of hills. Tonight, the rain in the northwest will move slowly southeastwards across the UK, becoming increasingly patchy as it does so.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Patchy rain will gradually clear southeastwards on Friday. Colder, clearer conditions then follow, with scattered wintry showers in the north. Elsewhere, a good deal of fine weather. Saturday, becoming wet and windy in the north, remaining largely dry further south.
