

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain will slowly clear northeastern parts of the UK, with sunshine and scattered showers elsewhere, some heavy. However, persistent rain and gales, locally severe, will reach southwest England in the afternoon and continue northeastwards during the evening and overnight. Rain will become more showery during the early hours but it will still be heavy at times.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
Heavy showers or longer spells of rain will continue on Wednesday and it will stay windy with further gales, severe around southern and western coasts. Fewer showers and lighter winds for many on Thursday but a spell of rain is possible in southern England.
