Headline:

Rain in the west. Many eastern parts fine. Very warm.

Today:

Dry and fine in many eastern areas. However, rain will affect Northern Ireland this morning, reaching other western parts this afternoon. Ahead of this some thundery downpours are also possible, especially in the north. Very warm or hot in many places.

Tonight:

Thundery rain moving east, allowing drier conditions to spread to most parts by dawn.

Outlook for Friday:

Mainly dry with sunny spells.
