Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A band of rain, heavy at times and accompanied by gusty and squally winds moving south-eastwards across England and Wales today, which will clear by late-afternoon. Early rain and strong winds will slowly clear away from northern Scotland, with sunshine and heavy showers following. Clear spells and showers overnight, mainly in the north and west. Staying windy.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:
Sunshine and showers on Thursday, these most frequent and heaviest in the north and west, with risk of thunder. Staying windy for most. After a frosty start on Friday, it'll be mostly dry, with sunny spells. Rain will arrive from the west overnight.
