Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Frosty at first, many parts will have a dry day with sunny spells. However, occasional snow showers are likely to affect parts of northern and eastern Scotland, and also eastern England. Further snow showers are likely overnight in the north and east, with a widespread hard frost.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:  
Remaining cold with hard overnight frosts. Snow showers are likely in the north of Scotland on Monday but many other parts should be dry. Snow showers will develop more widely on Tuesday, but are likely to be heaviest and most frequent in the east.
