Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Heavy rain in Scotland as well as northern and eastern England will clear eastwards. Further south, cloud will move to the east. Brighter, fresher weather will follow in the west, with showers in Northern Ireland. The rain will clear from northeast Scotland during the evening, leaving much of the UK dry overnight.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:
England and Wales will be mostly dry and breezy on Thursday with sunny spells. A few showers are likely in parts of Scotland, Northern Ireland and the far west of England. Friday will be dry and bright for most, though rain will affect the far north and west.
