

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Sunday 05 Oct 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Wales and the southern half of England will start wet. Dry and brighter weather will spread eastwards, to reach all but the southeast by dusk. Further north there will be sunny spells, with a few showers across Northern Scotland. Clear spells across many parts tonight will give a chilly night with patchy fog.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

After a bright start in most parts, it will become cloudier from the west with occasional light showers. More persistent and heavy rain will spread across England and Wales overnight to give a wet day on Tuesday. Further north it will be brighter with a few showers.
