Headline:

Rain, more persistent in south, slowly dying out. Misty overnight.

Today:

N.Ireland mostly dry with bright or sunny intervals developing.  
Brighter later in Scotland after rain clears. Rain spreading east  
across Wales and S.England, patchy rain further north.

Tonight:

Most places becoming dry with mist and hill fog developing. Rain and  
strengthening winds in northwest later.

Outlook for Friday:

Rain spreading from west to all but E.Anglia and the southeast.  
Blustery showers in northwest later.
