ROUGH AT FIRST EXCEPT IN CROMARTY, FORTH AND TYNE,  
OTHERWISE MODERATE OR ROUGH. SHOWERS. MODERATE OR GOOD

HUMBER THAMES  
SOUTHWEST 6 TO GALE 8 BECOMING CYCLONIC 4 TO 6. VERY  
ROUGH AT FIRST IN NORTHEAST HUMBER, OTHERWISE MODERATE OR  
ROUGH BECOMING SLIGHT OR MODERATE. SQUALLY SHOWERS AT  
FIRST IN THAMES, RAIN LATER. MODERATE OR GOOD,  
OCCASIONALLY POOR LATER

DOVER WIGHT PORTLAND PLYMOUTH  
SOUTHWEST 5 TO 7, OCCASIONALLY GALE 8 AT FIRST, VEERING  
NORTHWEST LATER. ROUGH OR VERY ROUGH IN WEST PLYMOUTH,  
OTHERWISE MODERATE OR ROUGH, OCCASIONALLY SLIGHT LATER IN  
DOVER. RAIN OR SQUALLY SHOWERS. GOOD, OCCASIONALLY POOR

BISCAY  
WEST BACKING SOUTHWEST 6 TO GALE 8, OCCASIONALLY 5 AT  
FIRST, VEERING NORTHWEST LATER, PERHAPS SEVERE GALE 9  
LATER. VERY ROUGH OR HIGH BECOMING ROUGH OR VERY ROUGH.  
RAIN OR SQUALLY SHOWERS. MODERATE OR POOR

FITZROY SOLE  
WEST OR SOUTHWEST VEERING NORTHWEST, 6 TO GALE 8,  
INCREASING SEVERE GALE 9 AT TIMES. VERY ROUGH,  
OCCASIONALLY HIGH AT FIRST IN WEST. RAIN OR THUNDERY  
SHOWERS. MODERATE OR POOR

LUNDY FASTNET  
WEST 5 TO 7, OCCASIONALLY GALE 8 AT FIRST, BECOMING  
CYCLONIC 3 TO 5, THEN NORTHWEST 5 TO 7 LATER. ROUGH OR  
VERY ROUGH, BECOMING MODERATE OR ROUGH EXCEPT IN  
SOUTHWEST FASTNET. RAIN OR SQUALLY SHOWERS. GOOD,  
OCCASIONALLY POOR

IRISH SEA

SOUTHWEST 6 TO GALE 8 VEERING WEST 4 TO 6. MODERATE OR  
ROUGH, OCCASIONALLY VERY ROUGH AT FIRST IN SOUTH,  
BECOMING SLIGHT OR MODERATE LATER. SHOWERS. GOOD

#### SHANNON

WEST 4 TO 6, INCREASING 7 OR GALE 8 LATER. VERY ROUGH OR  
HIGH. SQUALLY WINTRY SHOWERS. MODERATE OR POOR

#### ROCKALL MALIN

WEST 6 TO GALE 8, OCCASIONALLY SEVERE GALE 9 IN ROCKALL.  
VERY ROUGH OR HIGH, BECOMING ROUGH OR VERY ROUGH IN EAST  
MALIN. SQUALLY WINTRY SHOWERS. MODERATE OR POOR

#### HEBRIDES

CYCLONIC 5 TO 7, OCCASIONALLY GALE 8 IN FAR SOUTHWEST AND  
FAR NORTHWEST, DECREASING 4 AT TIMES ELSEWHERE. VERY  
ROUGH OR HIGH, OCCASIONALLY ROUGH IN EAST. SQUALLY  
SHOWERS. GOOD, OCCASIONALLY POOR

#### BAILEY FAIR ISLE

CYCLONIC 6 TO GALE 8, OCCASIONALLY SEVERE GALE 9 IN  
NORTH, DECREASING 5 AT TIMES IN SOUTH. ROUGH OR VERY  
ROUGH IN SOUTHEAST FAIR ISLE, BUT ELSEWHERE VERY ROUGH OR  
HIGH. SQUALLY SHOWERS. GOOD, OCCASIONALLY POOR

#### FAEROES SOUTHEAST ICELAND

EASTERLY BACKING NORTHEASTERLY 7 TO SEVERE GALE 9,  
OCCASIONALLY STORM 10 EXCEPT IN SOUTH FAEROES, DECREASING  
6 AT TIMES IN SOUTH FAEROES. VERY ROUGH OR HIGH IN  
FAEROES, VERY HIGH BECOMING HIGH IN SOUTHEAST ICELAND.  
RAIN OR WINTRY SHOWERS. MODERATE OR POOR
