Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Northern Scotland should be dry with plenty of sunny spells today,  
then clear spells tonight, although becoming damp and breezy in the  
far north later. Elsewhere generally dry, cold and cloudy. The best  
of any breaks will probably develop over western parts this  
afternoon. Light winds. Widespread slight frost returning tonight.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Most places will be cloudy, dry and cold with light winds on both  
Friday and Saturday. Less cold over Scotland and N.Ireland though.  
Breezy across northern Scotland with some light rain on both  
mornings. Some light rain over East Anglia on Saturday afternoon.  
Probably sunniest across eastern Scotland.
