Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A generally dry bright start but wintry showers over the north and east will develop quite widely during the day. Some of the showers heavy giving a temporary covering of snow over the hills. Showers mostly dying out tonight but a few continuing over the east and near coasts. Rain and snow affecting Northern Scotland. A widespread frost inland.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
It will remain unsettled with sunshine and further wintry showers. Some longer spells of rain or sleet are likely at times especially over Scotland with snow over the hills. It will be cold, and overnight frosts are likely in many places.
