
Daily Air Quality Index – Friday 17/06/2022




Daily Air Quality Index – Saturday 18/06/2022

Air Quality Forecast for the UK

Issued by the Met Office

Today: On Thursday, Moderate levels of air pollution are widely likely across much of England as well as parts of southeast Wales. Flow from the Continent is expected to add to locally produced pollutants. Low levels of air pollution expected elsewhere.

Tomorrow: Similar conditions are expected on Friday, with much of southern and eastern England experiencing Moderate levels of air pollution. Lower levels of air pollution expected elsewhere.

Outlook: Over the weekend, air pollution levels are likely to fall Low due to strengthening winds and fresher air replacing the Continental flow. However, some pockets of Moderate levels of air pollution may persist in far southeast England on Saturday. Confidence is low at this point.
