Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Saturday:- Cool, rainy and rather windy weather over Scotland will spread to much of Northern Ireland, while brighter weather with showers will follow to northern/Central Scotland.
England and Wales, largely dry with bright or sunny periods. becoming cloudier further north with some rain in Cumbria later. Feeling warm in the sunnier south.
Saturday evening/night:- Staying dry in the far south, but rain over Northern Ireland and SW Scotland, will spread to western/central Scotland; northern/central England and N Wales.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Dry/bright in northern Scotland and most of southern England: rain/drizzle elsewhere becoming confined to the far west on Monday.
Average temperatures; cool in the north at first.
