Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Cloud and patchy rain in the east of England will quickly clear through the morning. Elsewhere, there will be sunny spells and scattered showers, especially across the north and west. Most places becoming dry through the afternoon. Generally windy with coastal gales, severe gales in the far northwest. Winds easing through the evening. Feeling cold.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
Remaining dry in many southern and eastern areas, with some bright or sunny intervals. Further north and west it will become increasingly cloudy with outbreaks of rain in western parts on Friday, and more persistent rain spreading southeastwards on Saturday. Remaining windy. Temperatures near normal.
