Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:

A fine and dry day for many with sunny spells, although a few showers are still possible, especially in the east where they may be locally heavy for a time. Any showers will gradually ease away through the evening, to leave a largely dry night with clear spells. It will turn quite chilly in rural northern and central areas.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Fine, dry and becoming warm for many parts on Monday and Tuesday with sunny spells, but a few light showers are possible, mainly in the east. In the far southwest of the UK, it will be breezy with a chance of rain.
