

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Wednesday 28 Jul 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:

A generally rather cloudy day with scattered showers, these most frequent and sometimes heavy in eastern parts of Britain, while southwest England may remain dry all day. Some more persistent rain is also likely in western Scotland. Showers should die out this evening to leave a mostly dry night with some clear spells.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Most places staying dry with some bright or sunny intervals on Thursday. Scattered showers are again likely in eastern England, but fewer and lighter than today. Rain spreading from the west to all parts on Friday, with clearer conditions and occasional showers following into northwestern areas later.
