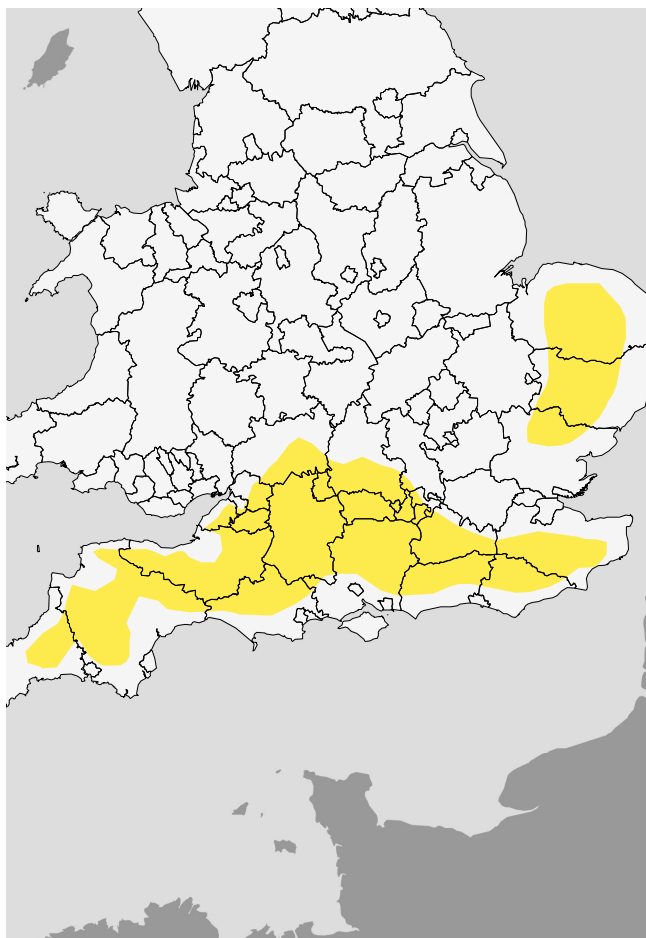

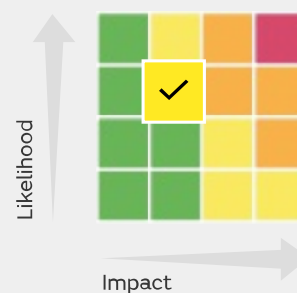
Icy stretches will be the main hazard on Saturday evening, overnight and Sunday morning

What to expect

- Icy stretches on many untreated roads, pavements and cycle paths, particularly where snow is lying.
- Increased likelihood of accidents and injuries due to icy surfaces

Further details

Most areas will be dry on Saturday although some wintry showers will continue to affect East Anglia. After dark, temperatures will fall rapidly and untreated wet surfaces, particularly those where snow has partly melted and then refreezes, will become very icy.
