

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Sunday 02 Mar 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Showers in the north on Sunday will be wintry in places, mainly over hills,
along with brisk westerly winds. Cloud and rain will spread to Wales and many
southern and western parts of England in the evening after a generally dry,
bright day here.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Most parts bright with some sunshine at times, but much colder. There will also
be wintry showers, especially in the west, these becoming more widespread
through the day with some snow, particularly on high ground. A frosty start on
Tuesday then further sleet or snow showers in the far-east, otherwise dry with
some sunshine but cold.
