Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
For many it'll be an exceptionally mild Christmas Day with outbreaks of rain. More persistent rain will edge southeastwards through the day and overnight, with colder conditions following into northern parts. Here it will also be very windy with frequent showers, these turning wintry later on.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Boxing Day will be windy with further showers in the north, though it should turn a little calmer and drier later. Elsewhere it'll be a fine but chilly day despite some decent periods of sunshine. Largely settled conditions will spread across much of the UK for Tuesday, though rain's possible in the far north.
