Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Mist, fog and low cloud at first, especially in eastern parts.  
Otherwise dry with sunny spells and just an isolated shower, possibly  
thundery, developing this afternoon. Very warm again, hot in the  
southeast. Mainly dry tonight, with evening sunshine. Mist, fog and  
low cloud again developing mainly over eastern parts. Thickening  
cloud possibly bringing rain into west Cornwall and N.Ireland later.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Misty start to Sunday, then sunny spells and showers in the east.  
Overcast with heavy and thundery rain spreading across western parts.  
Heavy rain over eastern parts on Monday with widespread, thundery  
showers in the west. Staying very warm.
