Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Many places will have a fine day with spells of sunshine and variable amounts of cloud. A lot of dry weather around but some showers are expected across parts of Northern England and Scotland. Winds will be generally light so it should feel pleasant in any sunshine.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:  
Becoming a lot more unsettled as we go towards the weekend with an increasing risk of showers developing. There should be some sunshine too but any showers that come along could be heavy with a small risk of thunder. Temperatures staying near normal for early June.
