Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Most places will have a fine day with some sunny spells. Patchy rain and drizzle across southern parts of the UK will clear during the morning. It'll be dry for most, though isolated showers are possible across the far east. Staying dry overnight, though chilly with clear spells, allowing a touch of frost to form in the countryside.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Most places will remain fine on Sunday and Monday, with some bright or sunny spells. However, it will be cloudier across parts of Scotland and Northern Ireland with some patchy rain developing at times. Overnight will remain chilly with clear spells.
