

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Largely dry and fine, with some warm sunny spells quite widely. However, scattered showers are likely to develop in the northeast, a few sharp ones are possible. Remaining largely dry overnight with clear spells, light wind and a few mist patches, but clouding over in the far southwest where there is likely to be some rain by dawn.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Cloud and patchy rain in the southwest will spread north and eastwards, reaching all but the far north and east later on Tuesday. A few heavier bursts are possible. Warm and humid on Wednesday, but often cloudy with some rain at times.
