Headline:

Rain, locally heavy spreading eastwards. Some drier, brighter spells developing.

This Evening and Tonight:

Becoming mainly dry, but further occasionally heavy rain will spread to central, and northwestern parts. Drizzly and misty in the west.

Thursday:

Rain locally heavy across Scotland and northwestern areas, drier with warm, bright spells in Midlands and Southeast. Isolated shower possible.

Outlook for Friday:

Cloudy with rain at times, but turning drier and brighter later. Warm in the south with thundery showers possible.
