Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
It will be a chilly day with plenty of sunshine in many places, though overnight fog may linger in parts of western England and east Wales. Wintry showers will continue in northern Scotland and some eastern coastal areas, and southwest England, particularly Cornwall and Devon, will remain generally cloudier with occasional light rain or drizzle.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:  
Outbreaks of rain, sleet and hill snow will spread eastwards across southern areas on Monday and wintry outbreaks will also affect the northern half of Scotland; elsewhere mainly dry but cold. Becoming generally more unsettled on Tuesday, with freshening winds in the north.
