Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Showers in many places, heaviest and most frequent in the west. Showers across northern and eastern Scotland will turn increasingly wintry. Also some showers affecting North Sea coastal areas. The best of the drier, brighter conditions for central and southeastern areas. Generally feeling rather cold in the brisk northwesterly breeze.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
Cold throughout, with a frost and ice risk overnight. Showers on Wednesday, mainly for eastern coasts, and feeling very cold in the northerly wind. Strong winds and more general rain, sleet and snow will arrive across Scotland on Thursday, and move slowly southwards during the day.
